PV Incentive Program
Program Opportunity Notice (PON 1050)

Applications accepted through December 31, 2009 by 5:00 PM Eastern Time

The New York State Energy Research and Development Authority (NYSERDA) requests applications from qualified photovoltaic (PV) installers for eligibility in a financial incentive program for approved PV systems installed for eligible New York State customers. Eligible customers are those who pay the Renewable Portfolio Standard (RPS)/Systems Benefits Charge (SBC) as a part of their electricity bill. PV system installers and dealers are encouraged to submit applications to become eligible installers. Installers can apply for eligibility at any time while the program is open. Eligible installers can then apply for financial incentives for approved PV end-use systems meeting the requirements of this Program. Additional funding may be made available, depending on funding availability, customer demand, and program success. The program will be implemented on a first-come, first-served basis.

Incentives are available to customers who use an eligible installer for new grid-connected, end-use PV systems for all end uses and sectors. Incentives are capped at 8 kW for Residential customers, 80 kW for Commercial customers, and 25 kW for Not-for-Profit customers. Incentives are for grid-connected systems only, based on direct current module ratings at standard test conditions.
