Program Opportunity Notice (PON) 1222  
**\$43 Million Available**

Applications accepted April 1, 2008 through December 31, 2009 by 5:00 PM Eastern Time\*

This Program Opportunity Notice is the second revision to PON 1222. This revision extends the closing date to December 31, 2009 and adds funding for Industrial & Process Efficiency. The natural gas and steam cooling incentive programs for Con Edison service territory are closed.

\$43 million is available through this PON to conduct technical assessments of energy efficiency improvements in building designs and to offset a portion of the incremental capital costs to purchase and install energy-efficient equipment in these buildings to reduce energy consumption. Applicants may choose among the following categories of incentives: Custom Measure (including prequalified equipment), Whole Building Design or the Green Building option. Incentives are offered for electric energy efficiency improvements, Combined Heat and Power, Advanced Daylighting, Demand Response and Industrial & Process Efficiency. Additional incentives and services are offered in all SBC utility territories for buildings that achieve LEED certification. Applications accepted beginning April 1, 2008 through December 31, 2009 or until funds are fully committed, whichever comes first.
